**ABSTRACT** – The purpose of this file is to serve as a guide for formatting the posters that will be presented at the 12th Spring School on Transition and Turbulence, EPTT 2020. The poster must be made in size A0 (841mm x 1189 mm) with a margin of 2 cm (right, left and bottom). The poster must also have the EPTT 2020 header, the title of the manuscript, name of all authors, affiliations, name and e-mail of the corresponding author and an abstract with no more than 500 words. These mandatory sections must appear, in this sequence, one below the other, from the top of the poster as shown in this model. The poster can be made with any editing software, as long as the presented guidelines and instructions are followed. Once finalized, the poster must be saved in PDF format and sent to the organization according to instructions available on the EPTT 2020 website (<https://eventos.abcm.org.br/eptt2020>). Make your poster as self-explanatory as possible. The poster's content must cover the same material of the accepted paper. Use color to highlight and make your poster more attractive, by using pictures, diagrams, cartoons, figures, etc., rather than only text wherever possible. Suggested font names and sizes for different types of text are presented in the table below. However, the smallest font must not be smaller than 9 mm high.
